
General Manager Perez reported that Board approval of this item is in preparation to move the election forward. Commissioner Diannitto asked for the names of the candidates and whoever was present to stand up. Candidate Ruben Navarro stood up. Candidate Tina Haro was not present. General Manager Perez stated the term will expire June 30, 2012 and there may be more candidates. The election will be won by plurality.

RESOLUTION 10029


Commissioner Diannitto moved that the Board authorize the General Manager to cause to be prepared, not more than 30 nor less than 20 days before the special election, a Notice of Election which document shall also include the Sample Ballot and the rules concerning eligibility to vote, for the 2009 Fire Department Active Employee Board Member Special Election, which was seconded by Commissioner von Voigt and approved by the following vote: ayes, Commissioners Diannitto, Hansell, Juarez, von Voigt, Wertman and President Aliano, – 6; nays, none. *Commissioner Juarez participated via teleconference.*
