Bill Raggio joined the Los Angeles Fire and Police Pension System in August 2007 and serves as the Assistant General Manager over the Pensions Division. In this role, Bill oversees all aspects of member benefits, including: active member services, service retirements, disability applications, surviving spouse and dependent minors/parents. The Division also administers the DROP program, maintains retiree personal and pension roll data and processes the monthly pension benefits.

Bill Raggio began his career with the City of Los Angeles in 1990. During this time, he has served in various capacities that exposed him to all aspects of City operations; beginning with a blue-collar, entry level position at the Department of Water and Power. He has also worked in the CAO's Office for seven years advising the Mayor and City Council on budget and policy issues related to the Special Parking Revenue Fund, the Capital Improvement Expenditure Program, and the Bureau of Engineering. Immediately prior to joining LAFPP, he served as the Budget Director of the Bureau of Sanitation, overseeing an operating budget of approximately \$332 million.

Bill received his Bachelors of Science degree in Business Management from Pepperdine University in 1994. He also graduated from the Southern California Leadership Network in 2004.
