

1. SOLICITATION OF CONTRIBUTIONS

Fiduciaries of the Los Angeles Fire and Police Pension System (LAFPP) are prohibited from soliciting, directing, or receiving any contribution from any person who is engaged in business for gain, seeking to engage in business for gain, or who has a proceeding pending before the BOARD or has had such a matter pending during the preceding 12 months.

Definitions:

1. For purposes of this Paragraph 18, "Fiduciary" is defined as a member of the BOARD, and executive and senior management staff.
2. "Person" means a natural person or business entity of any type, and includes all directors, partners, officers and agents of such business entity.
3. "Business for gain" is defined as any contract for goods or services, and any investment related contract.
4. "Proceeding pending" means all ministerial, administrative and legislative matters, potential contracts, current contracts and contracts with the BOARD that have expired or terminated within the past 12 months.

In the event any member of the BOARD or any executive or senior staff of the BOARD (see Exhibit B attached hereto), or any person claiming to represent or to have influence with either BOARD or with any member of the BOARD, contacts CONTRACTOR with respect to a contribution, CONTRACTOR shall promptly report by telephone and in writing such contact to the President of the BOARD and the General Manager.
